The Mount Horeb Summer Frolic is more than just a weekend of fun — it's a celebration with purpose every day. Each year, the Frolic raises vital funds to support our local parks and recreation, bringing health, joy, and connection to our entire community.

Thanks to generous support from local businesses like yours, we can make big improvements to our Grundahl Park, where we hold the festival each summer. This spring, we'll donate \$50,000 toward new playground equipment at Grundahl Park, and we're excited to be working with the Village of Mount Horeb Parks Department to design and build a new concessions and storage building next to the baseball field! This building will not only hold storage for Mount Horeb Youth Baseball and village equipment needed to maintain the field, but it'll also allow us to store our festival equipment and materials so they're easier to access for setup and teardown, reducing the workload on our volunteer team.

Additionally, Frolic proceeds will allow us to continue support of the **Wednesday Night Live** free summer concert series and consider other grants from community organizations.

The impact of your sponsorship goes far beyond upgraded equipment or a night of music, though. Well-maintained parks and recreational programs are crucial for children's development: They're where kids learn to collaborate, resolve conflicts, build friendships, and gain confidence. Each year, 60 percent of the Frolic's net proceeds go directly back to parks and recreation efforts, enhancing the quality of life here in Mount Horeb. The remaining 40 percent is shared among nine local youth sports and service organizations whose volunteers make the Frolic possible.

But we need your help. The costs of organizing a vibrant, safe community event grow every year, and this year, taxes have increased the price of fireworks and imported goods.
